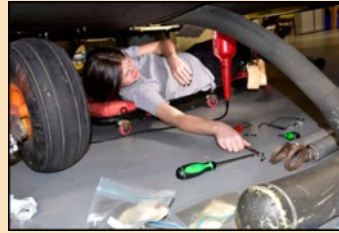

Huey 823 Restoration Progress

Our maintenance team discovered that 823's original tailboom was in need of a very expensive modification. As we considered alternatives we found a tailboom that had already been modified that we could acquire at about a quarter of the modification cost. We sent our new healthy tailboom to the good folks at [SureFlight](#) who stripped, painted, and stenciled it to the way it looked when 823 flew with the 170th in

Vietnam. Work continues today inspecting and assembling this very important and very complex part of the aircraft. Seeing this newly painted tailboom installed has given all of us a sense of what she will look like when completely painted, and we are very enthusiastic about it. Take a look and tell us what YOU think! Does anyone know what the Vietnamese phrase says? We know that the color

may look off to some, but keep in mind that the picture was taken inside under fluorescent lighting and also that there were a LOT of variations in colors in Nam. Rob, SureFlight's paint guru, carefully and accurately mixed this color to reflect what it looked like in 1969 in Vietnam.
